May 9, 2018

The regular meeting of the Foundation Board of Directors of Montgomery Community College was held on Wednesday, May 9, 2018 at noon in the College Boardroom in Building 200.

Present were: Jean Abbott, President; Sandra Miller, Vice-President; Roy Anderson, Dr. Chad Bledsoe, David Britt, Claudia Bulthuis, Dr. Katherine Dunlap, Susan Eggleston, Korrie Ervin, Earl Leake, Jeanette McBride, Gary McRae, Anne Samsel, and Courtney Atkins.

Absent: Lynne Russell, Jane Van Sinderen, Carolyn Saunders, and Matthew Monroe; SGA President.

Call to order – Jean Abbott

Mrs. Abbott called the meeting to order at 12:04 p.m.

Approval of the Agenda – Jean Abbott, President

Mr. Leake made a motion, seconded by Mr. Anderson, to approve the agenda for this meeting. The motion carried.

Welcome – Jean Abbott

Mrs. Abbott welcomed all in attendance including Jay Jacob from Wells Fargo.

Wells Fargo Presentation – Jay Jacob

Mr. Jacob gave an update to the Board concerning a recent Wells Fargo discrepancy.

Mr. Jacob presented Appendix E, Montgomery Community College's consolidated report.

He noted that the College deals with Wealth Management portion of the bank that recent discrepancies happened outside of the Wealth Management department.

Approval of Minutes – Appendix A, B, C, and D – Jean Abbott

Dr. Dunlap made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Miller, to approve the February 14, 2018 Foundation Board Minutes (Appendix A), March 1, 2018 electronic Foundation Board Minutes (Appendix B), March 13, 2018 electronic Foundation Board Minutes (Appendix C), and March 28, 2018 Finance Committee Minutes (Appendix D). The motion carried.

Finance Committee Report – Jeanette McBride

Last Quarter Performance Report – Appendix E

Scholarship Eligibility Recommended Revisions – Appendix F – Action

The Finance committee met and discussed scholarship eligibility. The Finance Committee recommended and Mrs. McBride made a motion to approve the recommended revisions to make Pell-grant cut off at \$15,000. Coming from committee, this required no second. The motion carried.

Montgomery Scholars Priority Deadline – Action

The Finance Committee recommends and Mrs. McBride made a motion to approve a priority deadline for Montgomery Scholars be set at April 1. Coming from committee, this required no second. The motion carried.

2018-2019 Scholarship Liability – Appendix G – Action

The Finance committee recommends and Mrs. McBride made a motion to approve the 2018-2019 scholarship liability not exceed \$218,340, allowing to pay for tuition and \$250 in books. Coming from committee, this requires no second. The motion carried.

Nominating Committee Report - Claudia Bulthuis, Chair

Re-Appointments – Action

Mrs. Bulthuis reported that the Nominating Committee met earlier and the members that have terms expiring have agreed to serve for the upcoming term. The Committee has asked for an adjustment in their terms. Roy Anderson and Earl Leake have asked for a two year term and Bill Hudson and Jean Abbott have asked for a one year term. The nominating committee recommends and Mrs. Bulthuis moved for approval of these terms. Coming from committee, this required no second. The motion carried.

Election of Officers – Action

The nominating committee recommends, and Mrs. Bulthuis made a motion to approve the reappointments of 2018-2019 officers of Jean Abbott, President; Sandra Miller, Vice President; Dr. Chad Bledsoe, Secretary; and Jeanette McBride, Treasurer. Coming from committee, this requires no second. The motion carried.

New Board Member

Mrs. Bulthuis also noted that the Foundation members will be looking for new Board members, and that any ideas of new members for the Board should be brought to Mrs. Ervin.

Treasurer Report – Jeanette McBride, Foundation Treasurer

Fund Statements – Appendix I – Action

Mrs. McBride reported on Appendix I-1 the Funds Statement ending in March 31, 2018, the funds value is down due to market loss and payment of scholarships. There is a positive net change of around \$327,000 since the start of the fiscal year.

Mrs. McBride reported on Appendix I-2 through I-4, the quarterly fund statements. She noted that \$53,000 of the endowed scholarships had been paid out in March, 2018.

Mrs. McBride reported on Appendix I-5 through I-7, the STIF account received a \$10,000 donation by Randolph Electric for the Drone program in February.

Mrs. Ervin noted the a STIF account created for the Woodsman meet event raised \$13,000 and any portion of money left over in the account goes back to the Forestry club.

Mrs. Miller made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Bulthuis, to approve the quarterly fund statements. The motion carried.

College and Career Promise Books - Appendix J

Mrs. McBride gave a report on Appendix J. Mrs. McBride recommended to re-establish the \$5,000 per year for textbook fees for CCP and Early College student.

Foundation Reports – Korrie Ervin, Director of Resource Development

Budget Review – Appendix K

Mrs. Ervin presented Appendix K. She noted the rollover of \$8,000 available for next year's budget.

2018-2019 Proposed Budget – Appendix L

Mrs. Ervin noted the estimated \$8,000 to roll over and other accommodations for fund needs. The fund for the Ambassador scholarship has grown over the years and the Business office has worked to spend that fund down by reimbursing the Foundation more than in previous years.

The Raffle budget was decreased this year to \$8,000.

Mr. Leake made a motion, seconded by Mr. Anderson, to approve the 2018-2019 Budget. The motion carried.

Occupational Scholarships – Appendix M

Mrs. Ervin reported that the \$8,000 in Occupational Scholarships given have been able to assist 35 students with \$3,500 remaining in the budget.

Human Services Mini-Grant – Appendix N

Mrs. Ervin presented that the Foundation Board had approved \$1,000 for the Human Services club to go on a trip to Tennessee, and she noted that the club raised an additional \$700 for that trip.

Mini-grant for Construction Day – Appendix O

Mrs. Ervin presented that the Foundation Board approved \$1,000 for Construction Day. Only \$269 of that \$1,000 grant was spent. She reported that the grant money went to food for volunteers and refreshments for businesses that set up.

Diversity Celebration – Appendix P

Mrs. Ervin reported that the Diversity celebration was very successful this year. They spent \$351 of the \$500 budget.

Golf Tournament – Appendix Q

Mrs. Ervin noted that the proceeds of the golf tournament were \$13,305. Mrs. Ervin noted some of the positives from the tournament; there was great support and participation from the Foundation Board and many employees volunteered to help. Next year they will be considering going back to a cash prize, having more publicity for this event and the possibility of using a new venue for next year.

Mr. Leake expressed concern about changing the venue noting the need to support the local golf course.

2018 Calendar – Appendix R

Mrs. Ervin noted Appendix R, the 2018 Event Calendar. The 2018 Fall Fundraiser will be held September 21, 2018 and the first annual 2018 Shooting Clays tournament will be held on Saturday, October 27, 2018.

Annual Fund Drive

Mrs. Abbott reported that the Annual Fund drive for 2018 has raised \$34,355, the largest growth since the year of 2013. An additional 357 names were contacted by the Foundation Board. This resulted in 40 new accounts being established.

President's Report

Dr. Bledsoe presented the annual report to the Board. He mentioned some of the highlights in the annual report from the Early College, the growth of Taxidermy and BLET program, and the HVAC program being taught at a facility in Biscoe.

There being no further business, Mr. Leake made a motion, seconded by Mr. Anderson, to adjourn the meeting at 1:18 p.m. The motion carried.

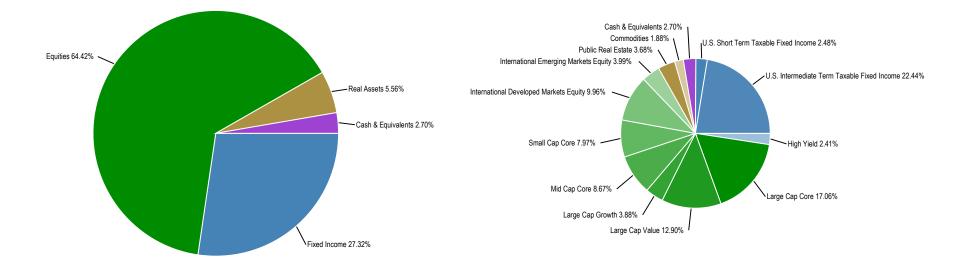

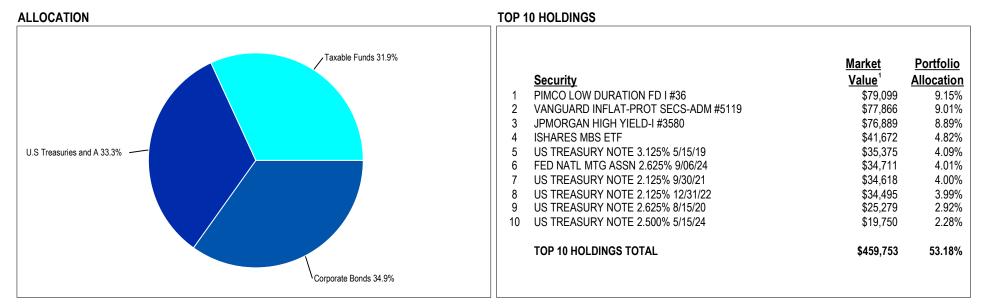

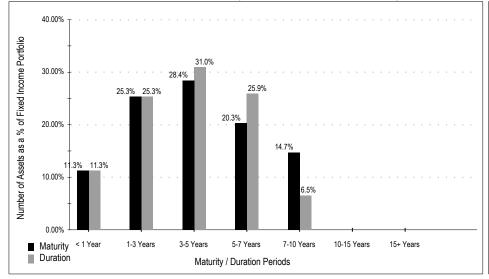

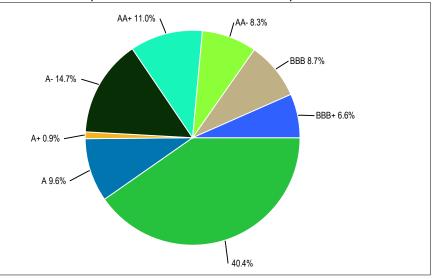

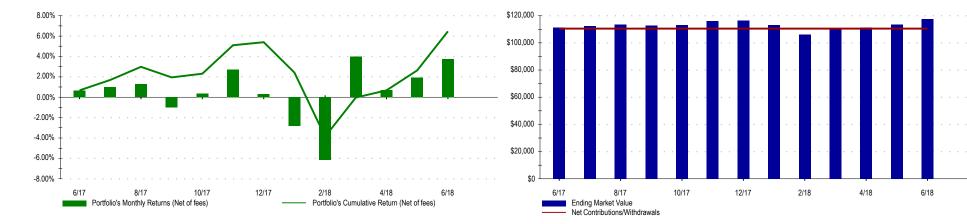

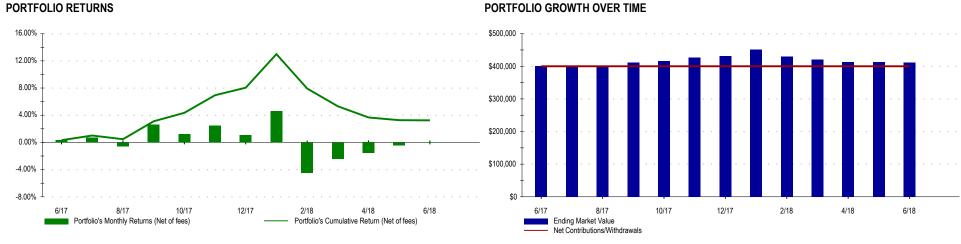
PORTFOLIO GROWTH OVER TIME

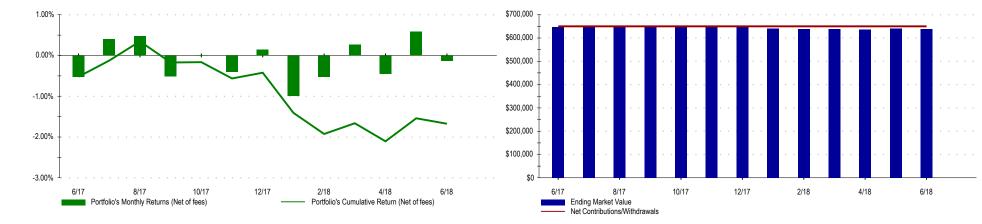

The Index consists of the following 21 emerging market country indices: Brazil, Chile, China, Colombia, Czech Republic, Egypt, Greece, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, Mexico, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Russia, South Africa, Taiwan, Thailand, and Turkey as of November 2013. The net index adjusts for reinvested dividends and accounts for foreign withholding taxes paid by money managers, thereby offering a truer picture of realizable returns available to U.S. investors.

Public Real Estate: FTSE EPRA/NAREIT Developed (FTSE EPRA/NAREIT Dvlp TR USD) is a market cap-weighted index designed to track the performance of listed real-estate companies and REITs in developed countries worldwide.

Commodities: Bloomberg Commodity Total Return (Bloomberg Commodity Total Return Index) reflects the returns that are potentially available through an unleveraged investment in the futures contracts on 19 physical commodities comprising the Index plus the rate of interest that could be earned on cash collateral invested in specified Treasury Bills. The Index is a rolling index rebalancing annually.

Alternative Investments Asset Group: Due to the unique nature of this asset group, Alternative investments manager performance is benchmarked differently than from fixed income, equity, and real assets. Performance is compared to peer group returns rather than a universe of potential investable securities.

The HFRI monthly indices are a series of benchmarks designed to reflect hedge fund industry performance by constructing composites of constituent funds, as reported by the hedge fund managers listed within the Hedge Fund Research (HFR) database. HFRI indices are net of all fees, updated monthly, and are equal weighted, which presents a more general picture of hedge fund industry performance by not biasing toward larger funds. The HFRI index series is more diversified (i.e., contains more constituents) than HFR's HFRX index series.

HFRI Relative Value, HFRI Macro, HFRI Event Driven, and HFRI Equity Hedge Indexes are each broadly utilized measures for performance comparison within their respective asset classes.

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Due to the unique characteristics of private equity assets (PE), including irregular cash flows and lack of reinvestment options, performance measurement is better assessed through different methods than those typically used for more liquid asset classes (which use

time weighted metrics) as such methods may not provide representative PE performance. In practice, PE funds are typically long-lived and interim estimates of returns must be based on implicit assessments of expected future cash flows. In order to more effectively gauge performance, PE generally uses two principal cash flow based performance indicators where capital calls, capital reimbursement and profit distributions are the basis for calculation: the internal rate of return "IRR" and the presentation of investment "multiples". IRR is the estimated rate needed to convert (or discount or reduce) the sum of the future uneven cash flow to equal initial investment or down payment. Multiples are calculated as the ratio of cash paid out (distributions) to total funds supplied (drawdowns or capital calls), but do not take into account the timing of the cash flows.

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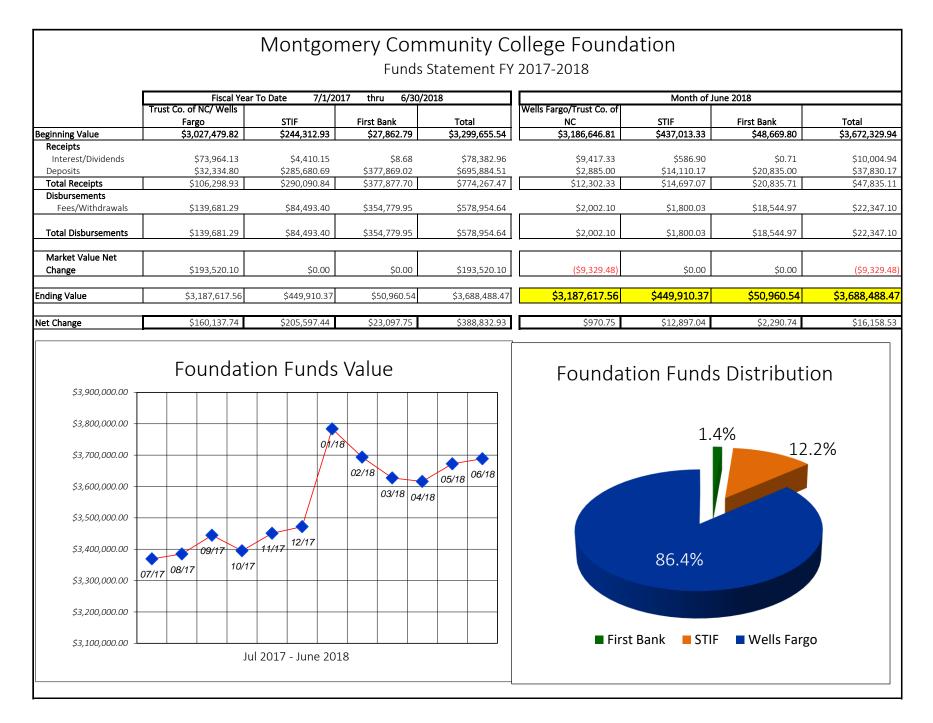
